In June 2016, the Law Council of Australia launched the National Model Gender Equitable Briefing Policy. The NSW Bar Association's Diversity & Equality Committee and the Women Barristers Forum have developed a three year strategic implementation plan to embed the principles of the Policy into the NSW Bar. In line with the strategic implementation plan, a Guide to Reporting under the Policy for barristers has been developed which includes a worksheet and reporting template.
