Rule 123 of the Conduct Rules provide that a barrister must not engage in conduct which constitutes, *inter alia*, discrimination and sexual harassment in the course of practice. Conduct of this kind may also amount to a criminal offence. It may lead to complaints with the Australia Human Rights Commission or the NSW Anti-Discrimination Board.

The seminar will address the current state of the law on sexual harassment and its relevance to barristers' practice by reference to case studies.
