The Government intends to legislate that the objective of the superannuation system is "to provide income in retirement to substitute or supplement the Age Pension". They have introduced

- ◆ A 1.6m cap on how much can be in pension mode and relevant penalties
- ◆ Concessional contributions cap reduced
- ◆ Non concessional contributions cap reduced
