EVIDENCE STRAND

The increasing number of class actions — fuelled by the growth in number of, and competition between, litigation funders — raises a number of issues for the judicial process. This seminar will address two such issues, which arise at opposite ends of a class action: commencement and settlement.

First, Perry Herzfeld will address the commencement of competing class actions concerning the same subject matter, and will consider the ways in which the courts have sought to address that circumstance.

Secondly, Jeremy Kirk will examine some of the concerns that can arise in relation to approval of settlements of class actions, and will consider whether and in what circumstances it is appropriate that the courts require that the parties appoint a contradictor to provide critical scrutiny to proposed settlements.
