# 2017 Cross Examination Workshop

The New Barristers Committee is conducting a workshop for juniors to further hone their advocacy skills. This year's (free) cross-examination workshop will be held in February-March 2017.

The workshop is designed particularly for junior members of the Bar to develop their cross-examination skills and is relevant to both civil and criminal practitioners.

## What does the workshop involve?

Form a group with your peers (say 4 barristers) and register for the workshop. If you are not able to form a group, feel free to register for the workshop and we will assist you in forming a group. You will receive an email containing the materials to be used for cross-examination demonstrations to be held on 27 March 2017 in the Supreme Court.

## Monday 27 February 2017

Seminar in the Bar Association Common Room starting at 5.15pm. The seminar will discuss cross-examination technique. The speakers will provide guidance on cross-examination in an open and relaxed forum, with questions from the floor. The speakers will be Michelle Painter SC (9<sup>th</sup> floor, Selbourne Chambers) and Kate Richardson SC (Banco Chambers).

## 27 February - 27 March 2017

Review the materials and in your group, decide on a mutually convenient time for you all to meet and conduct the mock cross-examination (for about 20 minutes each), with each person taking it in turns to be the witness and then examiner. Participants are encouraged to invite a more senior member from one of their floors to attend the mock cross-examination to provide additional guidance and feedback.

## Monday, 27 March 2017

Demonstration of cross-examination technique by two senior counsel in a mock trial based on the materials in the Supreme Court, Court 13A, starting at 5.15pm. The presiding judge will be The Honourable Justice Peter Garling RFD.
