**1.5 CPD POINT IN THE ETHICS
AND PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY
OR PRACTICE MANAGEMENT STRAND**

The tutor and reader relationship is an important and formative institution for successful practice at an independent Bar.

The twin aims of the Reading Program are (1) education and support, and (2) quality assurance and public protection. This seminar will present a review of the Reader/Tutor Guidelines and the Tutor Handbook, which provide information and assistance on several aspects of the relationship and which are intended to promote the objectives of the Reading Program.

The seminar will also raise some practical and ethical issues which are commonly encountered during the reading year from the different perspectives of readers and tutors. It will also consider some structures and techniques to develop the relationship in order to best meet the needs of the reader having regard to the objectives of the Reading Program.
